History of IPNU it is recorded that this organization has the length of Student Band Nadhlatul Ulama which was founded on 24 February 1954 in Semarang by Tholhah Mansur, while IPPNu has the length of Student Band Princess Nahdletul Ulma which was founded on 2 March 1955 in Malang by Hj. Machfudzoh Umrah. These two organizations are indeed founded in different years and have different guidelines or rules in running their organizations. However, often in running the program work is carried out simultaneously because there are several programs of work that are the same as the program of work which is routinely done every year in order to be more efficient. The organization can be followed by adolescents from the age of 12 to early adulthood at age 27. 1. INTRODUCTION

The website must also be able to attract the interest of general visitors so that they are interested in the activities and programs of the organization. In addition, it is also a place for content that reflects the values of IPNU IPPNU, such as Islam, nationality, and leadership skills. (Mistahus Surur & Agus: 2018) Features that need to be available include an activity calendar, current news, administrator profiles, educational materials, discussion forums, and a photo gallery of the PAC IPNU IPPNU Sidomukti sub-district.

PAC IPNU IPPNU has limited resources to develop a quality website. This can be an obstacle for PAC IPNU IPPNU Sidomukti to reach a wider audience as a source of information about activities, news, programs or others about PAC IPNU IPPNU Sidomukti, or also as a medium of interaction for PAC IPNU IPPNU with the general public other than social media which sometimes has limitations that cannot be met through social media. The development of the PAC IPNU IPPNU website as a utilization of information technology and a breakthrough to reach more students or non-students to be able to follow the latest programs or news more innovatively, informatively, effectively and efficiently. (Sulistiono & Arif: 2014) In its development, PAC IPNU IPPNU certainly faces many challenges in developing this website , including: availability of funds and resources, lack of experts in the IT field, lack of participation from NU students in Sidomukti District and Competition with other websites aimed at students.

2. METHOD

The implementation of this community service from the beginning of the website processing design class and the continuation of the implementation in the PAC IPPNU IPNU organization located in Sidomukti District, Salatiga City, Central Java Province with the implementation time starting from March 1, 2024 to June 30, 2024 with several steps, such as arranging permits with the caretaker of the boarding school, collecting interview data for analysis, designing the creation of a website design , uploading all information that can be accessed on the website page , conducting socialization and submission of the final results of the website with the boarding school administrators, then the last step is to compile a final report regarding all website creation procedures . The level of success of the method that has been carried out can be seen from the increase in skills or abilities of the students in managing the website and the achievement of visitor targets which make website traffic increase significantly.

3. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION




Figure 4.2. Main Page Explaining The Vision and Mission

On the main or front page (figure 4.2) we also include the vision and mission of the organization, so that readers immediately know the vision and mission of the organization.




Figure 4.3. About us Page

In the about us section (figure 4.3) an explanation is given regarding how this organization was first founded.




Figure 4.4. Activity Gallery Page

The activity gallery section (figure 4.4) contains documentation of activities carried out by the organization which gives an interesting and more millennial impression.




Figure 4.5. Contact Page

At the end (figure 4.5) the final page *of the website*, namely contact, contains contacts that can be contacted and the location of the secretariat of this organization.
